Asthma outcomes in a comprehensive community health centre program: a prospective assessment of patients. To prospectively describe the asthma outcomes for patients enrolled in an intensive comprehensive asthma intervention. All adult patients referred for a comprehensive asthma intervention program (n = 1523) were included in this study. All subjects received home visits and referral to community health centres to promote self-management. Health-care providers provided information to the subject's family on best methods to

---

control asthma and advice on daily management. Data were collected before the intervention and 3, 6, 9, and 12 months after the intervention. The outcome measures were as follows: asthma-related quality of life (using the St George's Respiratory Questionnaire); physician and patient assessments of asthma control (using the Asthma Control Questionnaire); health-related quality of life (using the Short Form-12); and medication possession rate (using the Medication Possession Ratio). The proportion of patients achieving and maintaining good control, according to

---

the physician and the patient, improved significantly from baseline to 12 months after the intervention. Patients who were adherent with medication, had fewer exacerbations, and had shorter emergency department and hospitalizations reported greater improvements in quality of life. A total of 68% of patients had a documented asthma control. Of these, 56% had good asthma control. The data show that in a comprehensive community health centre program, patients' asthma outcomes can be improved significantly. Study of antibiotic susceptibility of bacterial
